EMS expands military deliveries

Eitzen Maritime Services ASA today announced that delivery contracts between its Ship Supply division and the military forces of an undisclosed NATO country have been prolonged and expanded. In total EMS will deliver provisions under these contracts representing a total value of USD 68.5 million over the next 13 months. Compared to the original contracts, the expanded elements represent a value of USD 15.6 million.

EMS is serving this and other NATO customers from its Dubai facilities. This expanded contract is the fourth significant military contract for EMS so far in 2009.

EMS is a diversified maritime services group. The Ship Supply division is the world leader in ship supply and serves the merchant fleet, cruise and ferry fleets, fishing vessels, naval vessels and offshore installations around the world.
